The service learning project is a three part assignment.

Part 1:

Register for and participate in the Walk of Hope, which benefits the Jennifer Fallick Cancer Support Center in Homewood and Mokena. The center provides free comprehensive resources that help people improve their quality of life during the cancer experience. All programs are facilitated by experienced clinical professionals, and their services always are free of charge to anyone affected by cancer: the person with cancer, loved ones, friends, and bereaved of all ages.

Part 2:

Write a five page paper on a type of cancer. The topic is your choice. The paper is due by Tuesday, Dec. 1.

Part 3:

Write a two-page paper on the Walk of Hope or the Jennifer Fallick Cancer Support Center.
