Prairie State College District 515 serves the communities of Beecher, Chicago Heights, Crete, Flossmoor, Ford Heights, Glenwood, Homewood, Matteson, Monee, Olympia Fields, Park Forest, Richton Park, Sauk Village, South Chicago Heights, Steger, and University Park, plus portions of Country Club Hills, Hazel Crest, Lynwood, Tinley Park, and adjacent unincorporated areas of Cook and Will counties.

According to the Stevens Amendment Act, the grant funded portion of the Adult Education and Family Literacy program at Prairie State College for Fiscal Year 2013 is 34% financed with federal funds totaling \$182,310.00.
