

BENEFITS OF ROTC

After completing the first year of ROTC while enrolled at PSC, students are eligible to compete for scholarships:

- Scholarships vary, but most include a monthly stipend (\$150 or more/per month)
- Tuition reimbursements (amounts vary)
- Money for books

As a member of the military from Illinois, students are eligible for additional grants (the Illinois Veterans Grant*)

ROTC is a great way to improve a resume and learn leadership skills. It does not require a military commitment unless the student accepts a scholarship or enters into a third year of the program (check with ROTC detachment for details)

ROTC AT ILLINOIS INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY (IIT)

Air Force and Army

After earning your bachelor's degree, and completing all ROTC program requirements, you can be commissioned as an officer in the military.

After graduation you will:

- Be an officer in the military
- Receive additional pay and benefits
- Have a commitment to the military from four to six years (eight if a decision is made to become an Air Force pilot)
- You may also serve as a Reserve officer or as an inactive duty officer

BEGINNING FALL 2011

PSC students can participate in ROTC through a unique partnership agreement with Illinois Institute of Technology (IIT). ROTC courses are transferable and may be used as electives to complete your degree at PSC.

STEP 1

Fill out an IIT ROTC Application. An application is available on line at http://www.iit.edu/undergrad_admission/apply/pdfs/militaryscience_shimer_vandercook.pdf. At PSC, applications are available through ROTC coordinator Tiffany Bohm at tbohm@prairiestate.edu.

STEP 2

Meet with the PSC ROTC coordinator and register through the IIT's website. The PSC ROTC coordinator will assist you in selecting and enrolling in the ROTC courses.

STEP 3

All ROTC courses are held on the IIT campus in Chicago. You may drive or take the METRA Electric Line. IIT has a designated stop on the line.

STEP 4

Successfully complete your ROTC courses and apply for ROTC Scholarships.
