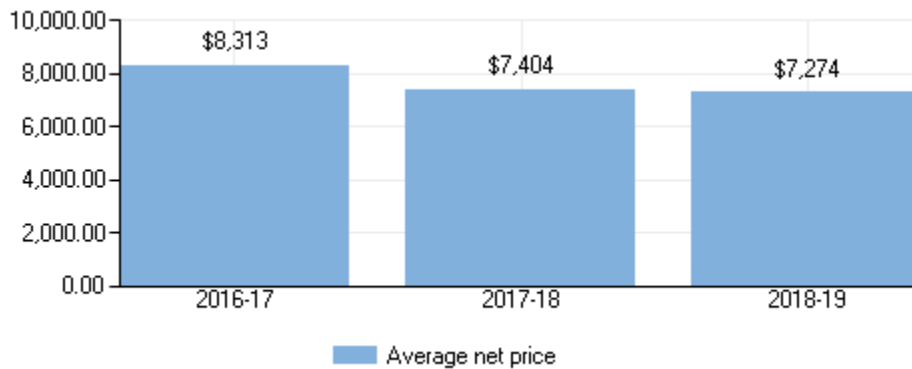

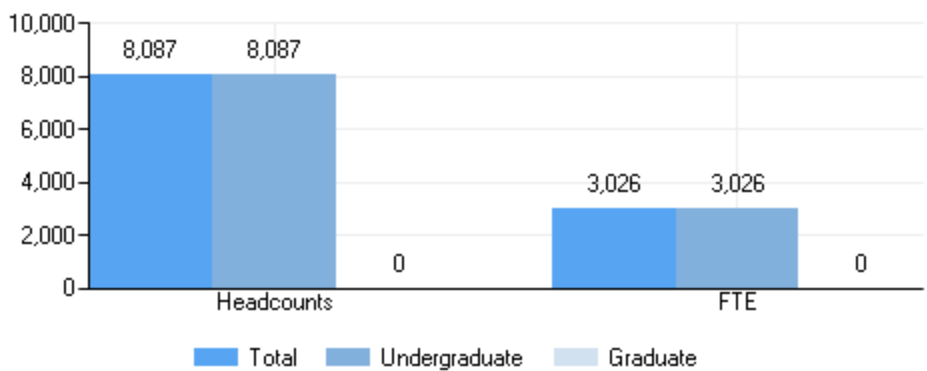

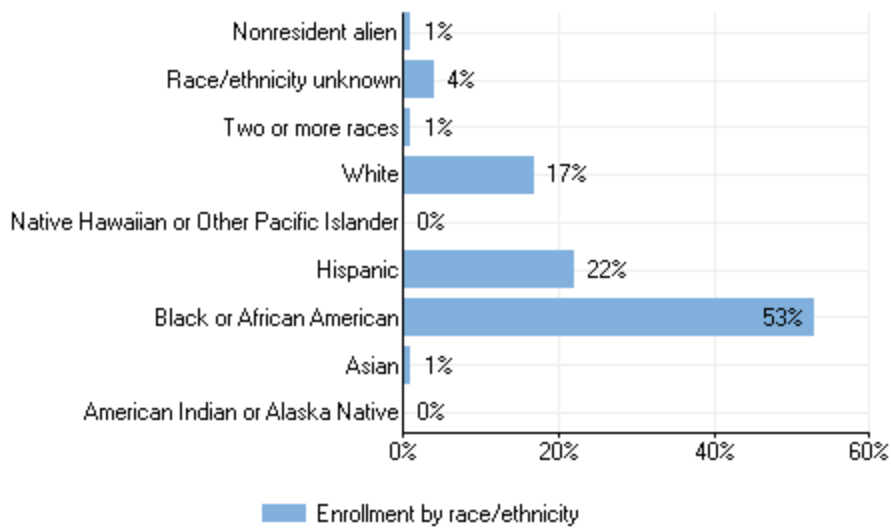
**Unduplicated 12-month headcount and total FTE, by student level: 2018-19**



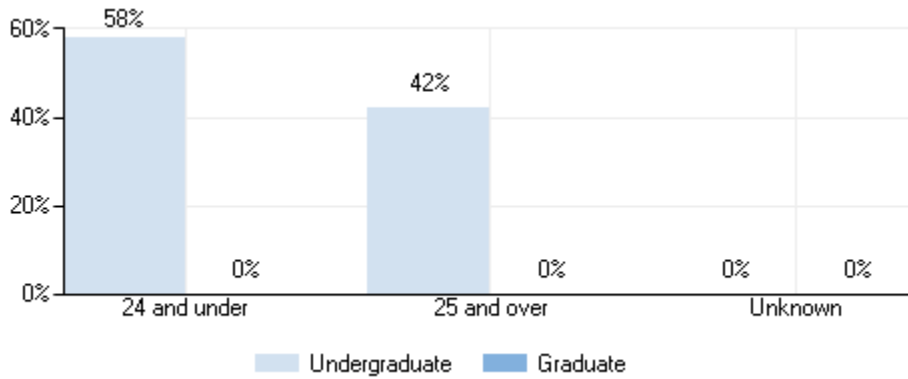

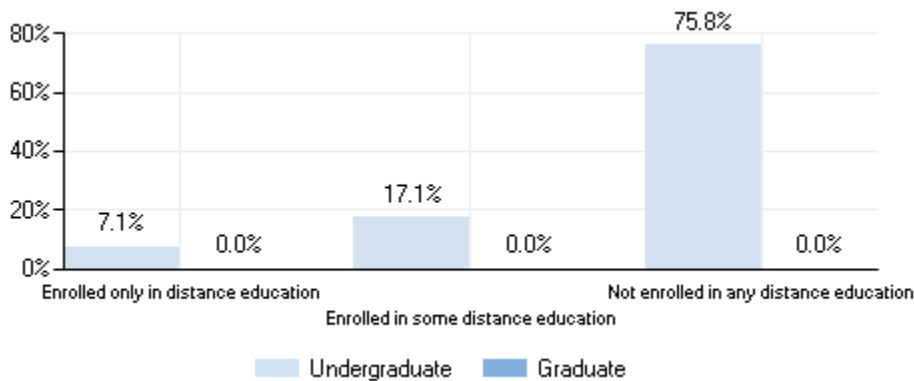
### Percent of all students enrolled, by race/ethnicity: Fall 2019



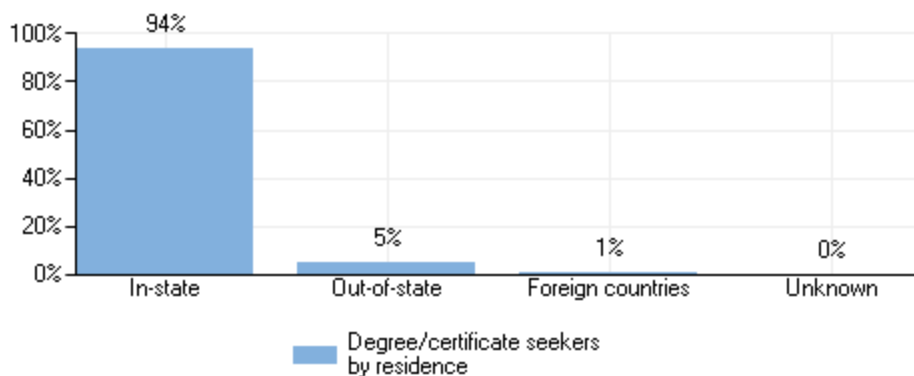
### Percent of all students enrolled, by age: Fall 2019

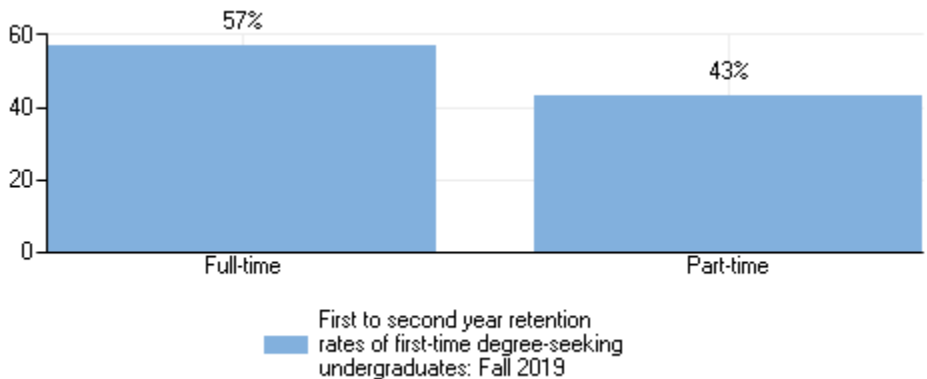

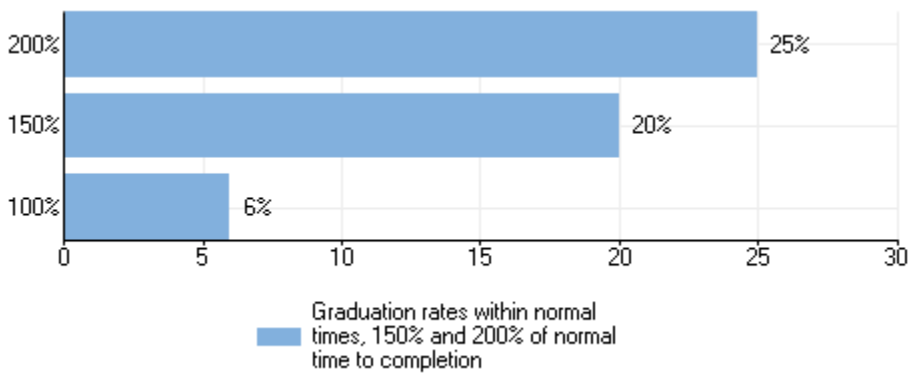

#### First to second year retention rates of first-time degree-seeking undergraduates: Fall 2019



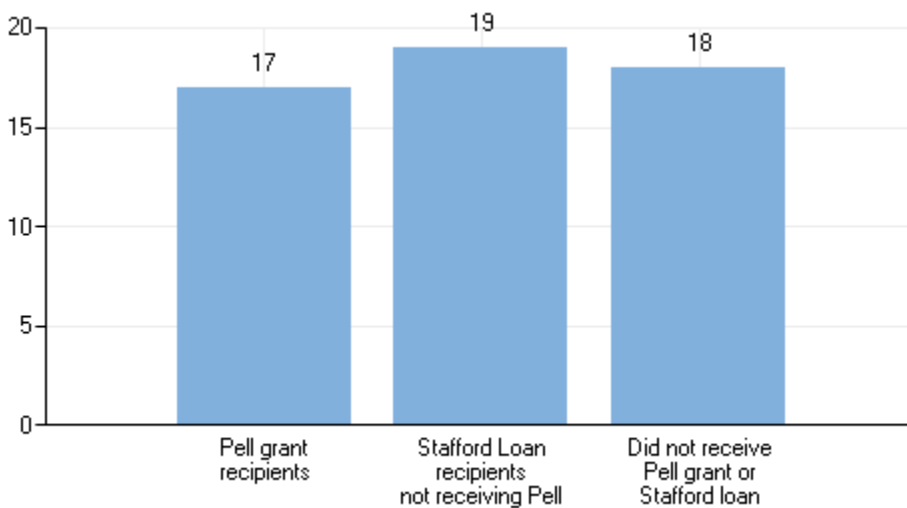

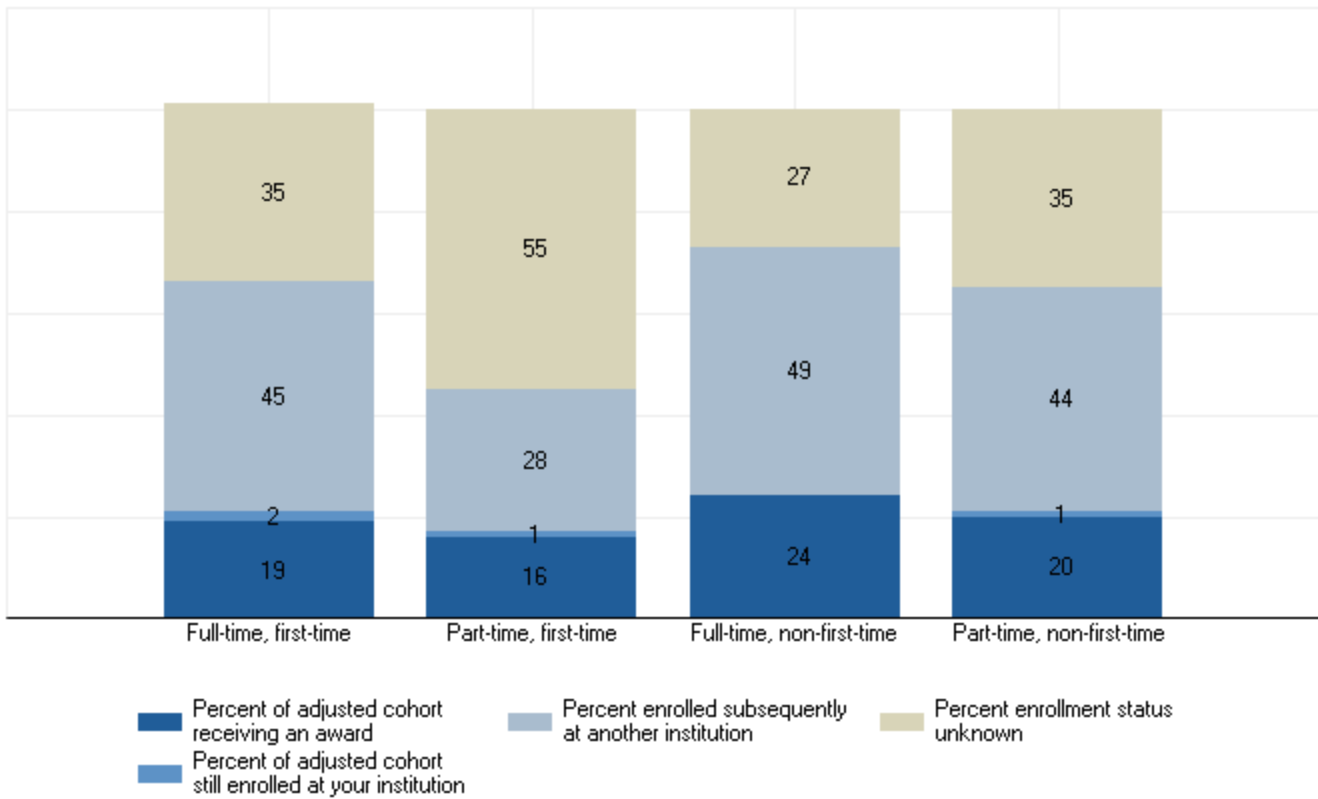

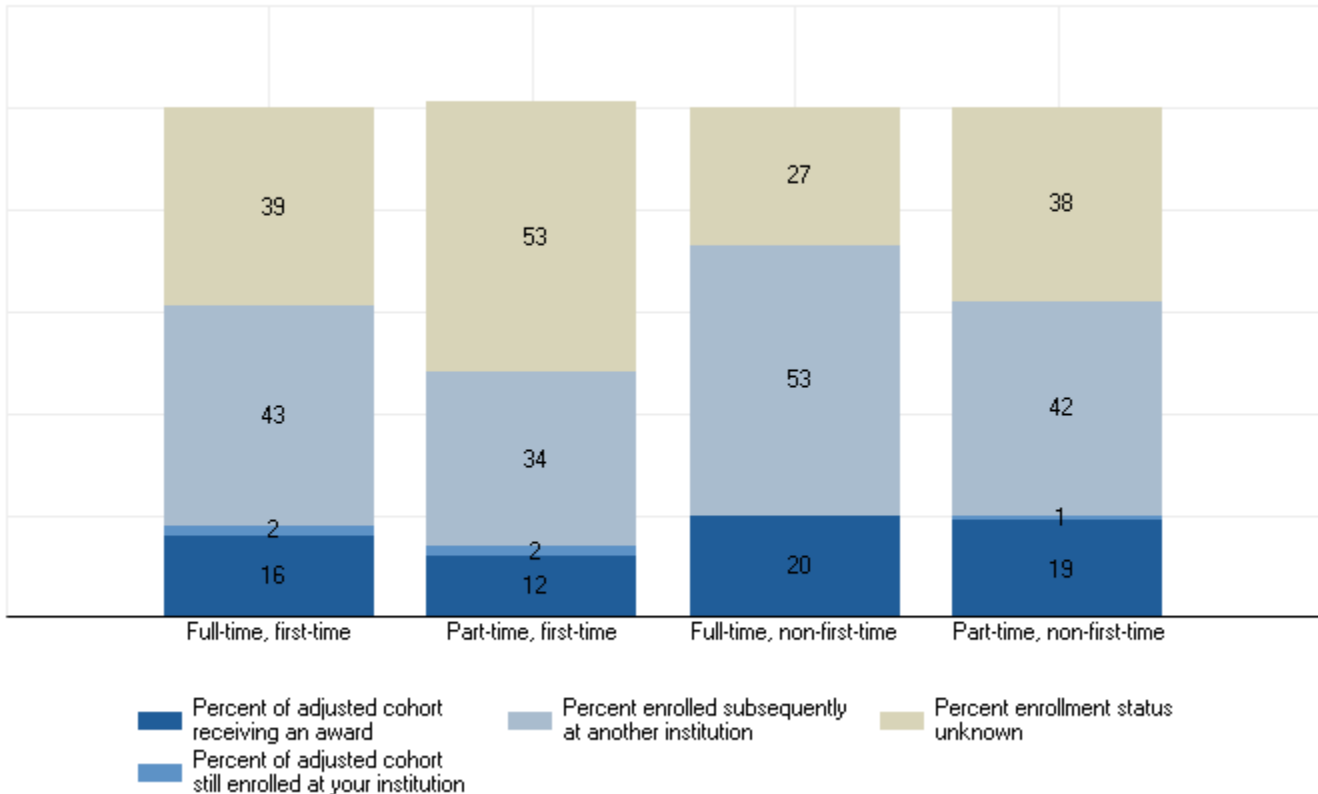

**Award and enrollment rates of degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who entered the institution in 2011-12, by cohort**



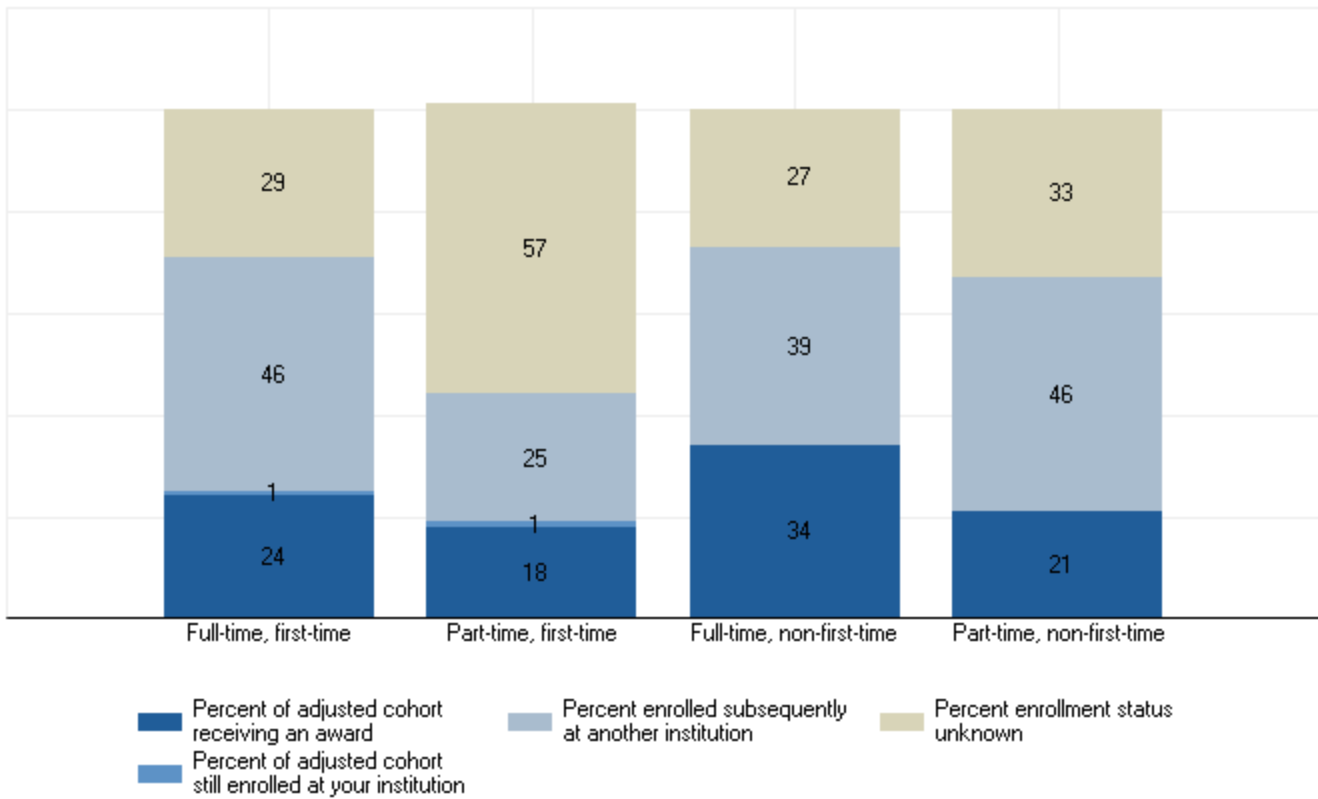
**Award and enrollment rates of degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who entered the institution in 2011-12, by Pell status and cohort**

**Students not receiving Pell Grants**

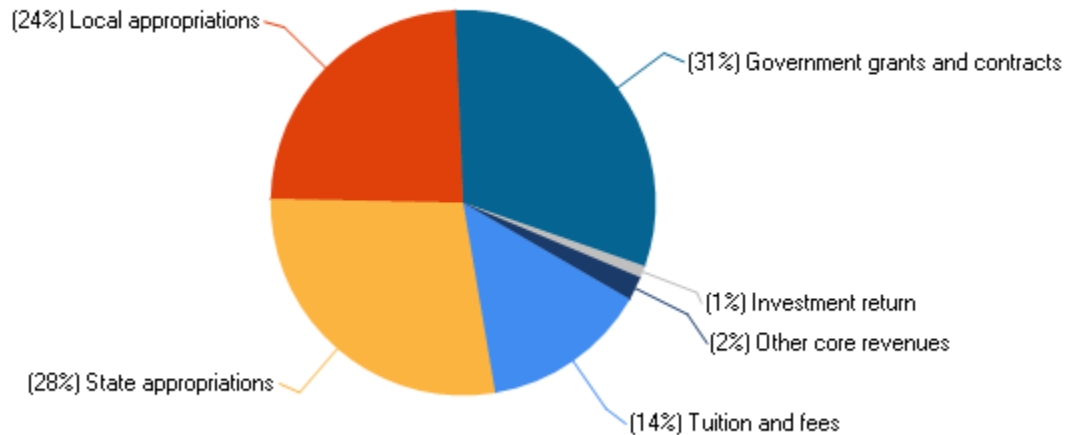

### Percent distribution of core revenues, by source: Fiscal year 2019

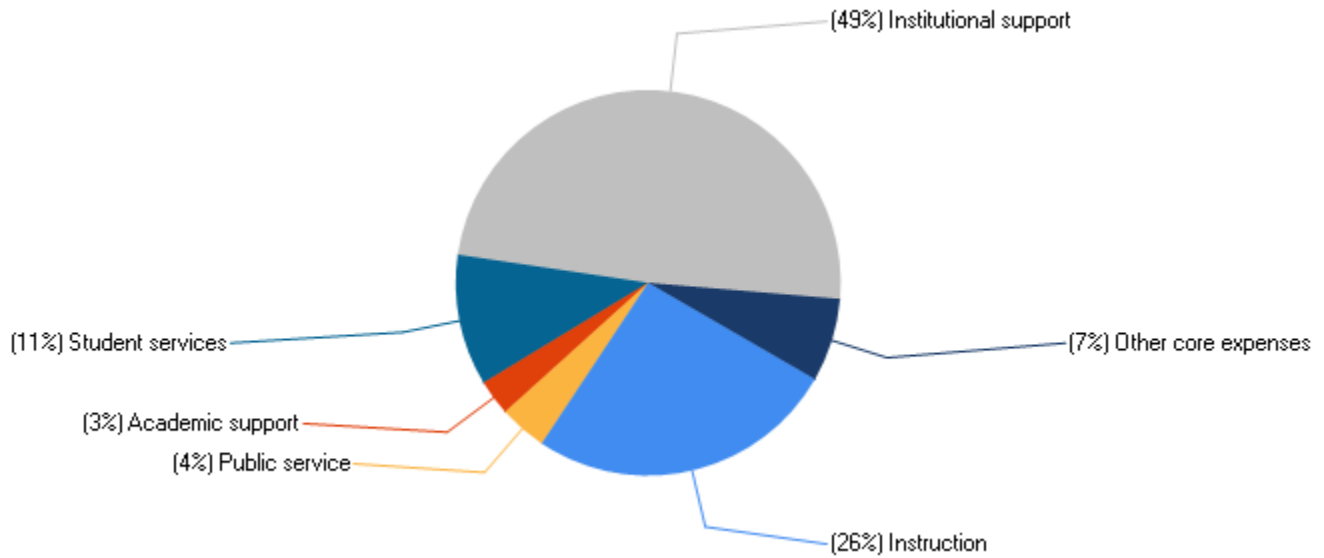

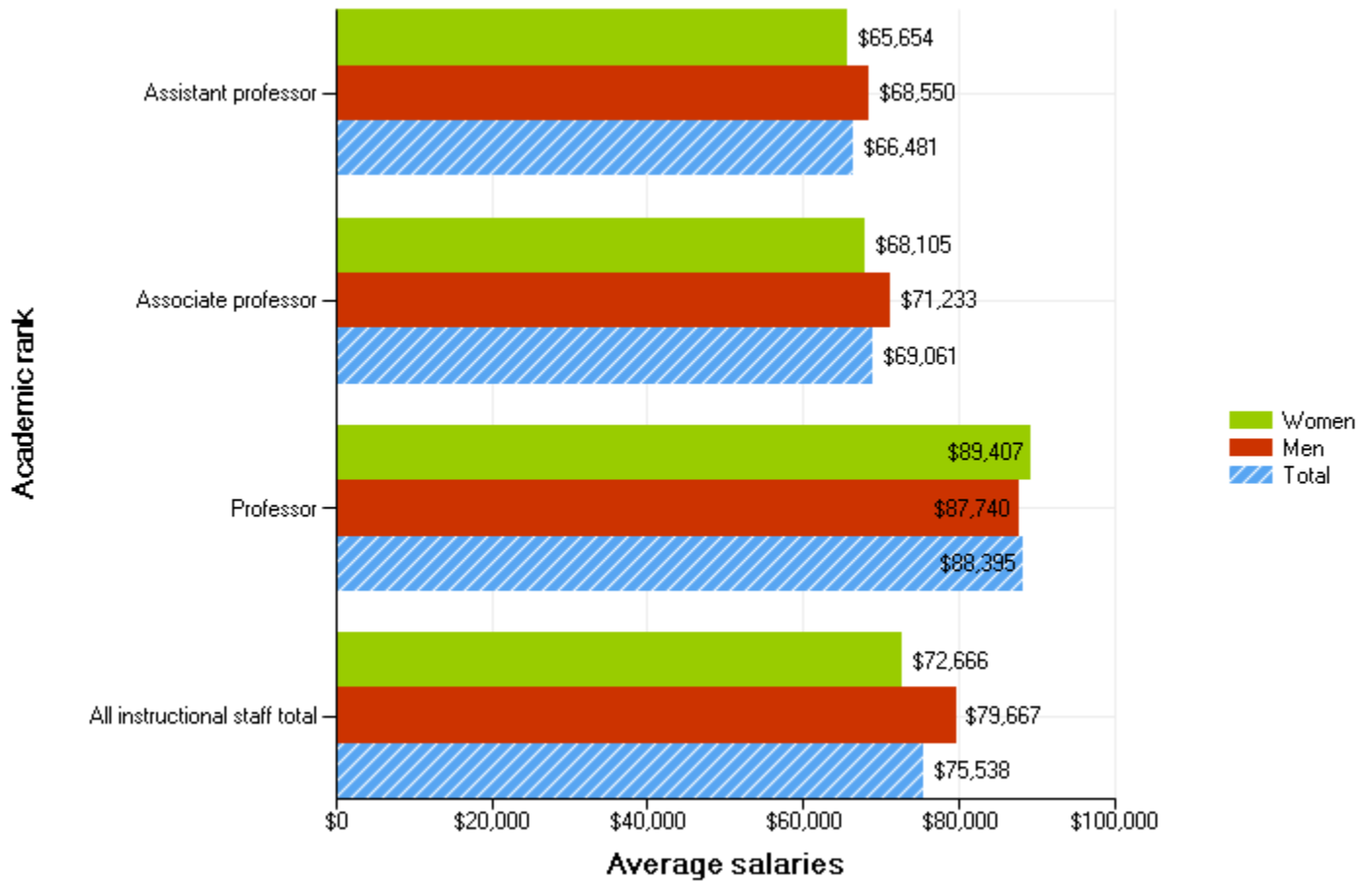

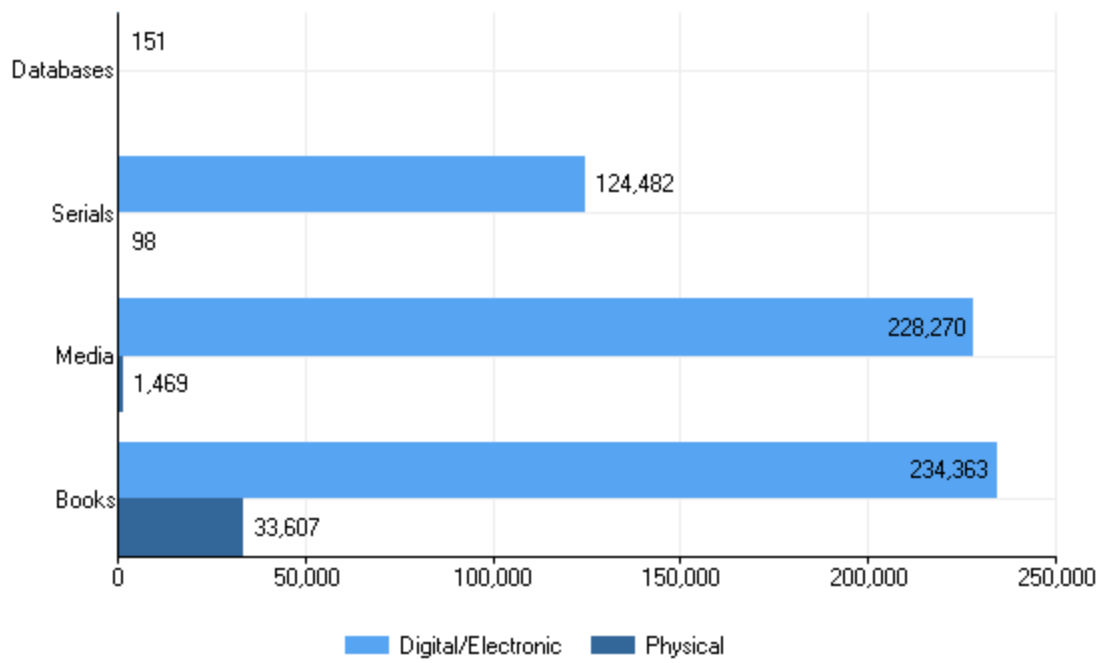
