Coaching Salaries

Prairie State College has 9 head coaches of its 9 sports. The total spent on men's head coaches is \$22,625 and women's head coaches is \$21,800. Our coaches are paid stipends.

Prairie State College does not have any full-time coaches. Of its 9 head coaches, only 1 is full-time college employees.

Prairie State College has 9 head coaches, there are 9 male head coaches and 0 female coaches.

Prairie State College has 9 assistant coaches in its 9 sports. There are 7 male assistant coaches and 2 female assistant coaches.

The total spent on men's assistant coaches is \$7,100 and women's assistant coaches is \$9,424. Our coaches are paid stipends.
