<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>U.S. Permanent Resident</b>  After we receive your document we will submit to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) for verification of your status. It can take up to 8 weeks for DHS to respond.	<b>Bring ONE of the following ORIGINAL documents to the Financial Aid Office:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Alien Registration Receipt/Resident Alien/Permanent Resident/Conditional Permanent Resident card (I-551, I-94, I94A)</li> <li>• Foreign passport with I-551 endorsement</li> <li>• Arrival/Departure Record I-94 with I-551 endorsements</li> </ul>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Other eligible non-citizen</b>  I-94 designated as "Refugee"; "Asylum Granted"; "Parolee" or "Cuban-Haitian Entrant;" or "Conditional Entrant"	<b>Bring the following ORIGINAL document to the Financial Aid Office:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Arrive/Departure Record (I-94, I94A or I-571 with proper endorsements).</li> </ul> <p><b>Note:</b> "Parolee" must be paroled for at least one year, and you must ALSO provide evidence from the USCIS that you are in the United States for other than a temporary purpose with the intention of becoming a U.S. citizen or permanent resident):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Application to Register Permanent Residence or Adjust Status (I-485) &amp; Notice of Action (I-797)</li> <li>• Petition for Alien Relative (I-130)</li> </ul> <p>After we receive your documents we will send them to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) for verification of your status. It can take up to 8 weeks for DHS to respond.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Victim of Human Trafficking</b> -OR- <b>Battered immigrant-qualified alien</b>	<b>Submit ONE of the following:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Copy of your eligibility letter from Health &amp; Human Services (HHS) or a T-visa</li> <li>• Copy of your I-797, Notice of Action form from US Citizenship &amp; Immigration Services (USCIS), with a valid expiration date verifying financial aid eligibility.</li> </ul>

<input type="checkbox"/>	<p><b>If you are in the US on an F1 or F2 student visa you are neither a citizen nor an eligible non-citizen.</b>                      If you are neither a citizen nor an eligible non-citizen you are ineligible for federal student aid. However, you may still file an annual FAFSA as in some cases you may be eligible for college aid.</p>
