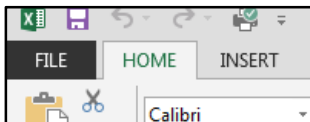


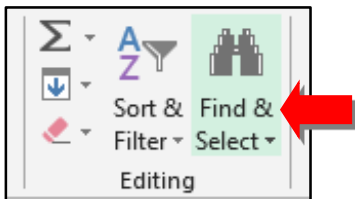
Print Visible Cells

In Excel 2016, you may have rows or columns on the spreadsheet that you do not want to print when printing the spreadsheet. You can hide those rows or columns so that they do not print.

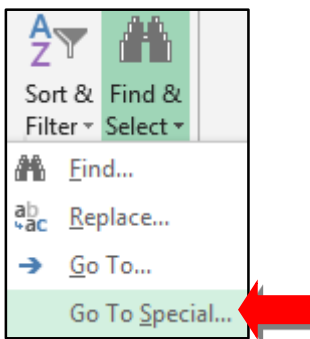
1. Right-click on the column or row to hide.
2. Select **Hide**.
3. Select the **Home** tab.



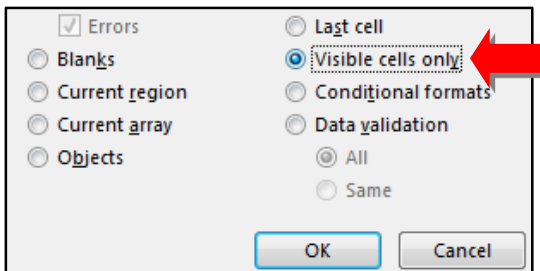
4. Select **Find & Select**.



5. Select **Go to Special**.



6. Select **Visible Cells Only**.



7. Select **OK**.
8. Select **File** then **Print**. In the preview window you will see that only the visible columns and rows will print.
